


# E-Safety at school, home and beyond...

Next Tuesday is Safer Internet Day 2018.

As a school, we take staying safe online and 'cyberbullying' very seriously.

Back in November, Mrs. Hardy led some work around

this issue, supported by those children who are members of our Digital Council. This week, some year groups have received workshops on the issues led by 'Big Foot' – and further activities will be delivered next week.



As teachers, we see children (particularly in Years 5 and 6) increasingly having access to smart phones - with all the benefits, and worries, that these bring with them. We recommend that parents and carers closely monitor children's use of mobile devices – and restrict access across some points of the day (especially before and during bedtimes!)

I am sure that, like myself, you will acknowledge that improvements in technology have opened the world to us all in ways we could not have imagined 30 or 40 years ago. However, as parents, we have all been left with challenges to manage, that our own parents and grandparents could never have imagined.
