Message from Chilton Town Council

The Town Council are very disappointed to advise that over the last couple of months we have had an increase in reports of vandalism & anti-social behaviour from youngsters in the town - particularly at our play areas. We are very fortunate to have so many diverse play areas; a lot of time and effort has gone into securing funding and maintaining the play areas - along with other associated financial costs. The Town Council feel it is vital for our youngsters to have safe areas to play, but sadly - due to the poor behaviour of a minority - it is becoming increasingly difficult to find the funds and time to maintain them. It would be appreciated if parents/carers could speak to their children advising them which play areas are suitable - and about nuisance behaviour and vandalism. If anyone witnesses any vandalism or anti-social behaviour - or can advise dates & times when the incidents occur - it should be reported. You could contact the police in confidence on 101 or call into the Town Council or telephone 01388 721788. Both the Police and Durham County Council have been advised about these concerns.
