### **Y6 SATs 2015**

### **Y2 SATs and Y1/Y2 Phonics Test 2015**

Y2 children are currently in their assessment period – and this will continue **until the end of the 2<sup>nd</sup> week in June**. All children in Y1 (and any in Y2 who did not pass in 2014) will sit the National Phonics Check from **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June until Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June**.
