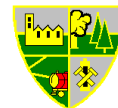

Parent Pay

Many thanks to parents who have already registered on line for Parent Pay. Today is the deadline for ordering Pay Point cards - we will assume if you haven't contacted school by today (several reminders have been sent out this week) that you don't require a card and have chosen the option to pay with debit/credit card on line. School is purchasing these cards - if in the future you need a replacement they will cost £1.50 each. If any parent requires help with registering their children or have any questions or queries please do not hesitate to call into the office as we are here to help. We have added the facility to pay for school fund/educational visits (the same as this year) - the only difference is the overall contribution of £40 which is due for the full year has to be paid in installments of at least £5. You will be able to see details once logged into your parent pay account.

TOP TIP: If you have more than one child to add onto your account don't try this with an I-Pad or phone - it will only register on a laptop/computer.
