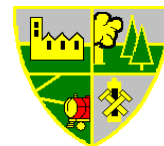

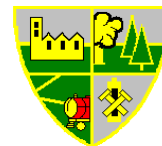

We had a really good morning and we hope to be selected again next year.” Reporters: Lexie and Mia (Year 3)

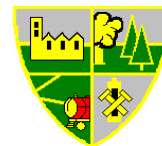
Reiki Classes – notice from Community College
