During the February school holidays a gate at the Pentlands Park was vandalised twice. Now as a consequence of deliberate vandalism the gate is now completely off along with another one which had to be removed for the same reason a couple of years ago. These gates are on the facility allowing children to play safely without dogs getting. Also due to the design of the gates they are difficult for younger children to open when inside the facility, this is to hopefully prevent them from running off.

The cost to repair & replace are very expensive and one that the Town Council should really not have to organise and ratepayers to financially fund. This park is extremely well used and a lot of hard work went into securing the funding and installation. It is the Council's intention to continue enhancing the park and only last year we successfully secured funding the fitness equipment.
