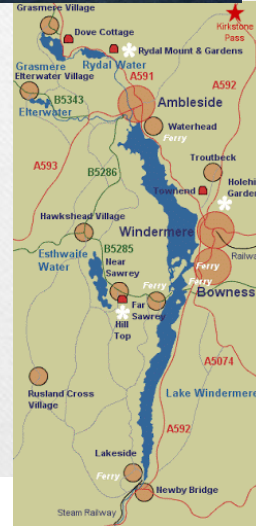
All about me:

Lake Windermere is the largest natural lake in the United Kingdom. **Windermere** is located within the county of Cumbria and the Lake District National Park. It has become one of the country's most popular places for holidays and summer homes.



Facts:
Lake Windermere is the largest lake in the UK, more than 11 miles (18km) in length, and almost 1 mile (1.5km) at its widest. The lake forms part of the border between Lancashire and Westmorland which are two of the UK's most historic counties. The lake also contains 19 different islands.

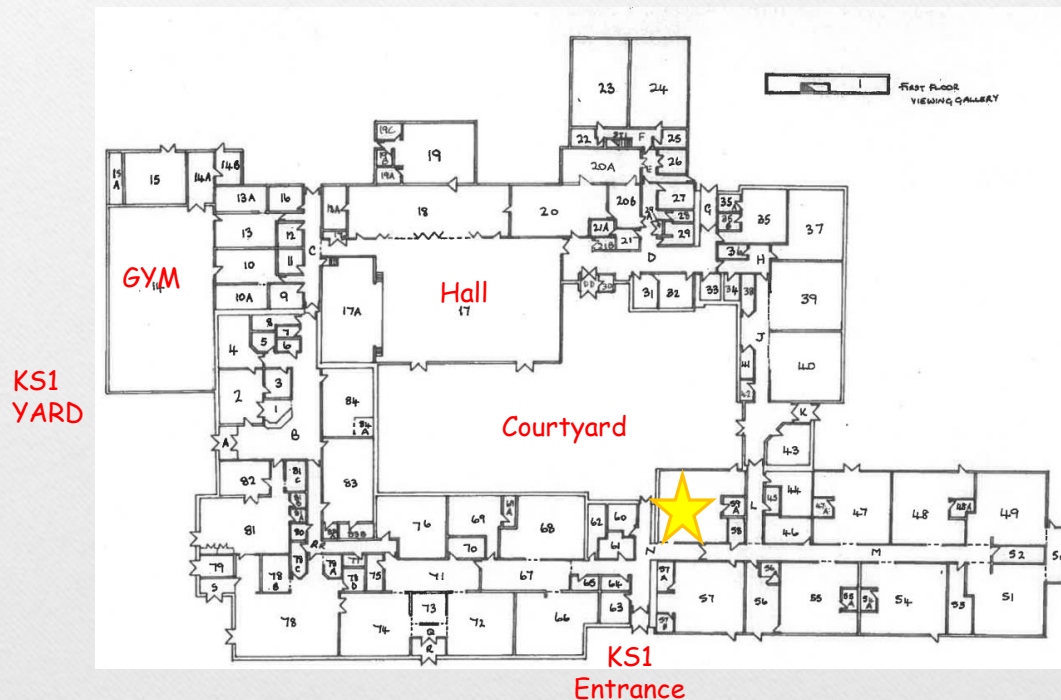
