
# It is nearly September

#### All about Snowdonia:

Snowdonia is the largest National Park in the North of Wales and it is made up of lots of beautiful landscapes and wildlife.

Snowdonia has 9 different mountains. The highest mountain is called Mount Snowdon which is very popular for walking up. As well as walking, there is a train which takes you to the top of Snowdon.



#### Facts:

- Snowdonia became a National Park in 1951.
- It has 3 protected areas which contains wildlife which are at risk from extinction.
- The Welsh name for Snowdonia is Eryri.

## Early Years Curriculum

There are 7 Areas of Learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), which activities are planned around:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Expressive Arts and Design Physical Development

Literacy -Reading and Writing Communication and Language

Maths

Understanding the World

## Early Years Curriculum

In PSED we will learn that people have some things in common - but also the differences which make us special and unique. It also includes our relationships with others, knowing the importance of kindness and respect.

PD is learning to use our bodies and the space around us safely and imaginatively, including big movements like jumping and climbing and small movements like threading and holding a pencil.

CL is using language to understand what we hear and to express ourselves and share information - talk, listen, ask questions, explain, tell stories etc.

In EAD you will
learn to express
your ideas and
feelings in lots of
different ways Art, Dance and
Music.

Literacy builds on the skills learnt in CL. It also includes the development of phonic skills.

In UTW we learn about nature, places, people and important events as well as ICT.

In Maths we learn about using numbers in lots of different ways to count, measure and solve problems. We will learn about shapes and positions of objects or patterns in the environment.

## Reception Times


- KS1 gates open at 8:35am
