Swimming and the national curriculum

Since 1994, swimming and water safety has been a statutory element of the national curriculum for physical education in England. All primary schools must provide swimming and water safety lessons in either Key Stage 1 or 2.

Each pupil is required to be able to do the following:

Perform safe self-rescue in different water based situations

Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres

Use a range of strokes effectively, for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke.

Due to Covid restrictions our Year 6 leavers at Chilton Academy, before this academic year, have not been able to participate in swimming lessons since 2018/19 Academy year. Due to this, Chilton Academy increased our SLA with Durham Swimming to double to amount of swimming lessons each child in Key Stage Two had this year.
